## DAPOL PLANS SECOND RUN FOR IT'S NEW 'OO' CLASS 59

HE POPULAR Class 59 Co-Co 3,300hp heavy freight diesel locomotive is set for a second production run with Dapol following the success of the first which touched down in December 2022.

The new batch of 'OO' Class 59s will offer modellers a choice of five new liveries which will be released DCC ready, DCC fitted, DCC sound fitted, DCC smoke fitted and DCC sound and smoke fitted.

The Class 59s were the first US built privately-owned locomotives to operate on the main line British railway network. The first were ordered for Foster Yeoman, the Class 59/0s, with follow on orders for Class 59/1s for ARC and Class 59/2s for National Power. Subsequently new owners and liveries have appeared on the class with examples now seen carrying GBRf, Freightliner and DB Cargo liveries.

The new batch will model 59004 *Paul A Hammond* in later Foster Yeoman colours (Cat No. 4D005-004), 59201 *Vale of York* in EWS maroon and gold (4D-005-005), 59101 *Village of Whatley* in revised ARC livery (4D-005-006), 59002 *Alan J Day* in MRL green and orange (4D-005-007) and 59206 *John F Yeoman* in Freightliner orange (4D-005-008).

Features of the models include printed nameplates and optional etched plates, cast wheels, a diecast chassis, all-wheel pick-up, NEM coupling pockets and an optional exhaust smoke effect. Digital functionality includes independent
